The Nile solution delivers a robust security model by default and there are no “add-ons.” For example, End-to-end MACSec encryption secures against potential sniffers or rogue devices. Nile also uniquely ensures every element in the system authenticates itself, thus preventing man-in-the-middle or rogue device attacks.

No more complex configurations

The specter of configuration and lifecycle management looms large for IT departments in every company. When it comes to security patches or software upgrades, many IT pros hope the upgrade is successful while still worrying that any patches or upgrades may bring the entire network down.
